



Two Colour Paper Plane




1. Precrease




2. Valley fold upper side down.




3. Precrease to make a small pinch.




4. Mountain inside to pin-point pinched creases.




5. Valley the tip.




6. Valley.




7. Mountain back.




8. Mountain fold in half.




9. Valley. Note intersection X.

11. Reverse point in. Valley both wings out at 90 degrees.



12. Because of the weight at the end. It is very easy to launch the plane to fly at a reasonable distance.
